


# Downloading Library eBooks - Kindle

1. In an internet browser, open up your library's website. Find an ebook you would like to check out. Follow your libraries steps in checking out. Be sure to check out the Kindle format.




2. Once you have checked out the book you should see a page similar to this to download the book. Click "Get for Kindle" button.



3. A window will open. Click "Get library book".



4. Sign in with you amazon username and password.
